**Summary\*\***

Between October 2019 and October 2021, in the context of the Mexican Agency for International Development Cooperation, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Mexico, through the National Institute of Statistics and Geography, and the Office of the Deputy Minister of International Cooperation of the Ministry of Economy, Planning and Development and the “José Joaquín Hungría Morell” National Geographical Institute, are collaborating on the international cooperation project for capacity-building in the project on methodology for the development of a toponym gazetteer of geographical names for 1:50,000-scale cartography of the Dominican Republic. The main objective is to provide assistance with using the Manual for the National Standardization of Geographical Names of the United Nations Group of Experts on Geographical Names to create the national gazetteer of the Dominican Republic.
